Plaintiffs Irene Kaufman and Bernice Kaufman, as trustees of the Irene Kaufman Trust ("Plaintiffs") respectfully request an extension of time until November 19, 2012 to respond to the order to show cause entered by the Court as Pre-Trial Order No. 38 on October 15, 2012 for which a response was required by November 5, 2012.

In support of this motion, counsel states that the effects of Hurricane Sandy has resulted in substantially reduced internet and communications capacity and lack of electric power to counsel's home and the inability of counsel to reach their office. This has resulted in counsel being unable to adequately respond to the order to show cause in a timely manner.
