We write on behalf of Lead Plaintiff Locals 302 and 612 of the International Union of Operating Engineers – Employers Construction Industry Retirement Trust (the “Operating Engineers”), Plaintiff New Jersey Carpenters Health Fund (the “New Jersey Carpenters”) and Plaintiff Boilermakers-Blacksmith National Pension Trust (the “Boilermakers”) (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) and proposed-intervenor Iowa Public Employees’ Retirement System (“IPERS”) in the above action.

In response to the Joint Motion to Intervene filed by Plaintiffs and IPERS (collectively, “Movants”) on August 11, 2010 [Dkt. No. 138], Defendants submitted their Opposition on August 24, 2010 [Dkt. No. 141]. Movants’ reply is currently due to be filed on September 3, 2010 pursuant to the Local Rules of the Court.
