CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER (CTO-15)

On February 9, 2009, the Panel transferred 9 civil action(s) to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1407. *See* 598 F.Supp.2d 1362 (J.P.M.L. 2009). Since that time, 21 additional action(s) have been transferred to the Southern District of New York. With the consent of that court, all such actions have been assigned to the Honorable Lewis A Kaplan.

It appears that the action(s) on this conditional transfer order involve questions of fact that are common to the actions previously transferred to the Southern District of New York and assigned to Judge Kaplan.




